




Mothers Pray






Royal Tribe Church (RTC)








Young Married Couples' Lunch





he Trustees present their annual report together with the audited financial statements of the charity for the year 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022. Objectives and activities

tangible progress.


Activities undertaken to reach out to the Community:






















Dining With Christ (DWC) Global
